Dear SFX Families

Thank you to members of our SFX Parents Association for putting on another school fundraiser at the Federal election last Saturday. So much work and preparation goes into events like this and it is so rewarding to the SFX Parents Association Exec when parents come out of the blue and offer their services... "I can help for an hour.....I can wrap this...I can bake a cake...." The use of SFX Hall by the Australian Electoral Commission is gaining popularity and it is good for the community to come into our school and see our facility. According to AEC statistics 1335 people voted at the SFX hall and this was a marked increase from when it was used for the Referendum voting last year.

Always remember that every cent of SFX Parents Association Fundraising goes into buying/paying off tangible, legacy items for the students. It is never used for gifts, wages or flowers etc.

2026 PREP ENROLMENT

Most would have seen the new 2026 enrolment signage around Montmorency declaring our Prep enrolment is now open.

Actually, we have had many families ahead of the game who have already enrolled for

which means that a third Prep class in 2026 is now likely. These families should receive their letter of offer in mid May. School tours ramp up to twice a week this term and one of the joys is leading families around our school. Most have come on the tour as they have heard great things about SFX. Word of mouth from our families is responsible for the majority of our enrolments and for this we are thankful.

SCHOOL CAR PARK

If you choose to park your car in the school carpark after school, you need to have entered the carpark before 3.20pm. You must always pick up your child from inside the school grounds and walk them safely to your car, using the crossing at the top of Kiss & Drop. At no point are children to be waved across the Kiss & Drop line and oncoming traffic by their parents. We have had two near misses in the past couple of weeks and both times it was the parent's fault and not the driver's fault by not following school protocols.

SCHOOL DENTAL PROGRAM

We are pleased to advise you that our school has engaged Semper Dental to provide your children with the opportunity of visiting the Semper Dental treatment team at school commencing on **Friday 23rd May.** Semper Dental is a well-respected catholic family business and is a significant provider of oral hygiene education and dental treatment services with programs running in more than 80 schools in greater Melbourne. The program is available to participating students from all year levels at the school. The basis of this offer will be fully explained in the Semper Dental parent consent forms and in the Semper Dental information flyer.

Semper Dental provides a preventative treatment program involving an oral examination and treatments such as scale, cleaning, fluoride application and fissure seals where necessary. Semper Dental will then provide you with a treatment plan for your child following the visit and will inform you if your child requires additional dental care.

Forms need to be returned to the school by Monday May 19th.

A day of Prayer & Preparation




- Learning how to receive the Bread and Wine



Cookie Dough Bites

Ingredients:

- 1 cup flour (heat-treated*)
- ½ cup butter, softened
- ½ cup brown sugar
- 2 tbsp milk
- <u>1 tsp vanilla extract</u>
- ½ cup chocolate chips

Instructions:

- 1. <u>In a bowl, cream together</u> the butter and sugar.
- 2. Stir in the milk and vanilla.
- 3. Add the flour and mix until combined.
- 4. Fold in the chocolate chips.
- 5. Roll into small balls and chill for 15-20 minutes.

Enjoy!

*To make raw flour safe, spread it on a baking sheet and bake at 160°C (325°F) for 5–7 minutes, or microwave for 1–2 minutes until it reaches 74°C (165°F).
