I sincerely hope that all the Mothers and Caregivers in our school community had a wonderful day on Sunday. It is so good that we honour our mums and that we do all that we can to make the day special. I hope that our SFX mums in particular enjoyed their gift from their child. Thank you to members of our SFX Parents Association for the time and effort taken in sourcing many hundreds of gifts for our Mother's Day stall. The students put such thought into making sure the gift they purchase is 'just right' and something that their mum would love to receive. Thanks also to the parents who staffed the Mother's Day stall for most of Thursday ensuring that every student purchased a gift. Final thanks to the sub-committee of our SFX Parents Association who organised our 'outdoor breakfast' and yoga session this year. It was so nice to have 'real' coffee, tea and yummies, and they had a chance to take a commemorative photo with our balloon garland. It was so great that so many mums were able to go back to the classroom and share some time with their child/ren. Well done everyone.

#### **CHANGE OF MONDAY MORNING PROCEDURE**

Monday morning assemblies tend to be longer now that we have interschool sports and birthday announcements, and our patriotic observance with the singing of our national anthem. The objective is that learning and specialist classes need to commence by 9.10am, not leaving much time for inviting parents in for Monday morning prayer. As such on Monday mornings we will trial our Year 6 Jubilee Leaders, James and Poppy, leading a whole school prayer at morning assembly. Thus there will not be in class prayer on a Monday morning. So our weekly morning timetable will look something like this: Monday-Flags, Anthems, Announcements, Prayer @ assembly Tuesday – Meditation – Parents most welcome to join the class Wednesday - Normal assembly - Parents may join class prayer Thursday – Normal assembly – Parents may join class prayer Friday - Meditation - Parents most welcome to join the class Just a reminder that there are few schools that offer parents the opportunity to come into class for morning prayer. It is a very SFX thing to do. If we are to continue this lovely practice parents must ensure:

- 1. That toddlers and parent discussion do not interrupt the prayerfulness and calmness of the classroom
- 2. That at the end of the prayer/meditation parents slip out of the classroom quietly. If your child becomes distressed by you being there, it may be wise to leave this opportunity until they are ready to accept your

presence in the classroom. It is certainly not an opportunity for an impromptu parent teacher chat. Nothing should stand in the way of learning at SFX.

# **PETITION TO BANYULE COUNCIL**

Following on from the SFX School Advisory Committee meeting last week, the recommendation was to make one further and final plea to parents to sign the attached petition and return it to school. We have less than 80 signatures at present and our goal was to have at least 200 signatures, if we want our requested changes to be taken seriously by Banyule Council. It would be great if parents could actively go out and solicit signatures from impacted neighbours. Another issue we have recently discovered is that many of the buses that we now use for excursions are 61 seaters and are longer and more difficult to turn around with our current traffic arrangement. Wouldn't it be great for our buses to approach the school by entering Lilicur Rd or Woodlands Grove, quick drop off at school and exit by Mayona Rd onto Mountain View Rd? Cars could also do this is in a pinch.

#### **CROSSING MAYONA ROAD IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL**

We have recently had some students crossing Mayona Road in front of the Church and the Year 1 classrooms. When asked why students are doing this they say 'my parent told me to do this'. Apart from being contrary to school policy, you are placing your child in great danger as they often leave the kerb between parked cars to cross Mayona Road. By far the safer option is to walk to the corner of Mayona Road and Mountain View Road where drivers have clear line of site of pedestrians who are needing to cross.

#### **SEMESTER ONE WORKING BEE – A TO K FAMILIES**

We have been able to land on a day for our first SFX Working Bee of the year. This will be held on **Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2025.** We invite all A to K families, mums and dads alike, to assist with the many jobs that need to be done around the school from 9am to 12 noon.

The big job for this working bee is disposing of our three water tanks. We have tried to move them on to someone that will use them, however the \$15,000+ cost to acquire them has made them a dead school asset. We would like to make this a more usable part of our school yard. More information about the tools we will need for this job will come at a later date.



This change would significantly improve safety, accessibility, and efficiency for everyone in the community, including traffic flow on Mountain View Road.


We request that the council conduct an urgent traffic study and implement necessary infrastructure changes to facilitate this improvement.




