### **2022 SCHOOL MUSICAL "ROCK BOTTOM"** Ticket sales were off to a flying start last Monday as the box office opened for our school musical spectacular.

All current Prep to Year 6 students will be expected to attend Magis Performing Arts Centre (MPAC) at Loyola College 325 Grimshaw Street Watsonia on <u>BOTH</u> nights.

SFX students will not need to purchase a ticket as they will be performing on stage in our school musical spectacular. Even our new 2022 Preps will be on stage for their first official introduction to the SFX community.

This year there will be no limit to the amount of seats that can be purchased, however the better seats will obviously be sold first on the online portal. Unlike previous years, families can invite grand parents and relatives so that we can provide the students with an authentic theatre experience and audience. Tickets this year are priced at a similar level to our last SFX performance in 2018 with the added benefit that anyone who purchases a ticket will have access to an online video of either performance #1 or #2. Gone are the DVD sales that used to happen after the performance...like everything in 2022 the video can be downloaded from a secure online SFX portal. Families are then not paying \$25 for a DVD. It is now included in your ticket cost for all families to play whenever/ wherever they want.

The historical significance of our SFX sports teams is as follows:

**Loyola (Blue)** - Jesuits order founded by St Ignatius of Loyola. The Jesuits engaged in missionary work and education.

**McAuley (Red)** - Catherine McAuley, the founder of Sisters of Mercy. Catherine began working with the poor, sick, homeless and founded a refuge.

**Xavier (Yellow)** - St Francis Xavier is the patron saint of missions. Francis Xavier met with many

difficulties however his amazing energy and courage spread Christianity from India to Japan.

**Padua (Green)** - St Anthony of Padua was a Franciscan priest who preached about God's love & forgiveness & showed love to the poor.

#### MOBILE PHONES & SMART WATCHES AT SCHOOL

As of January 2020, James Merlino the current Minister for Education banned the use of mobile phones in all Victorian schools. I would strongly encourage parents to not allow children to bring mobile phones or smart watches to school. I have noticed a significant spike in the amount of children walking out of the school gate in the afternoon carrying a phone and checking their latest social media. Please do not be influenced by your child saying *"we are now allowed to bring phones to school"* or *"everyone has a phone at school"*. This is not true. Mobile phones for primary aged students are unnecessary, are a distraction, and can lull parents into a false sense of security that a child walking home with a mobile phone will keep them safe.

My deepest concern is for students who walk home in a trance like state staring and engrossed in their mobile phone, often with their ear buds in, oblivious to oncoming or turning traffic and then crossing the streets dangerously because they are not using their eyes or their ears to monitor the street environment. Nonetheless if a mobile phone is lost, damaged or stolen, the school cannot be held responsible for replacing the phone or paying out the contract. If mobile phones are seen by a staff member during school time within the bounds of the school, they will be confiscated and parents will need to

collect these from the Principal's office. Another new trend is for some students wearing Smart watches to school, calling and sometimes messaging parents from their Smartwatch. Again this is a totally unnecessary and very expensive distraction. If parents need to be contacted during the day or if parents need to contact a child this can be easily done through the school office. Once again the school will not be responsible for replacing or repairing a lost, stolen or broken Smart watch.
