Dear Parents,

We are pleased to provide onsite supervision for your child during this Remote Learning period.

The service will begin at **9am** and entry will be **via the Mayona Rd entry only**. A teacher and myself will be there to temperature check your child before entry (*as now mandated by the Victorian State Government*). If your child's temperature is **37.5 or above** you will need to take them home, (*also now mandated by the Victorian State Government*) and get them COVID19 tested just as a precaution. Please remember to maintain 1.5m distance between you and other families dropping off their children. Staff will be wearing PPE for their own and the safety of others. You may wish to let your child know that this will be the scenario. Students will be dismissed at 3:30pm from this same gate also.

In order to maintain appropriate COVID-19 safe practices, we ask your child to bring their own pencil case with coloured pencils, textas, scissors and glue, etc. They will also need to bring any work and books for the day that they have been assigned by their classroom teacher. This will include the Chromebook/lpad that they have been loaned through the school. Your child is also welcome to bring a colouring book, puzzles, a personal device, an activity they like to do independently etc for when they complete their Remote Learning tasks for the day. These items will be for your child's personal use and will not be shared with other students.

Students will need to wear their school uniform. Prep - Year 2 students may wear their PE uniform on a Wednesday and Year 3 - 6 students may wear it on a Thursday. They will need to bring some healthy snacks, recess and lunch as per a normal school day. They will need a water filled drink bottle to begin the day. They will be going out to play at recess & lunchtime, however the adventure play equipment continues to be out of bounds.

Any student arriving late to school (after 9am) will need to be signed in by you through the main office and your child will be escorted to their classroom by a staff member.

St Francis Xavier School will continue to maintain stringent hand hygiene practices, therefore your child and staff will continue to use hand sanitiser and wash hands regularly during the day. Should you have any further questions please do not hesitate to contact me at the school.
