When I get up today I will be going to school.

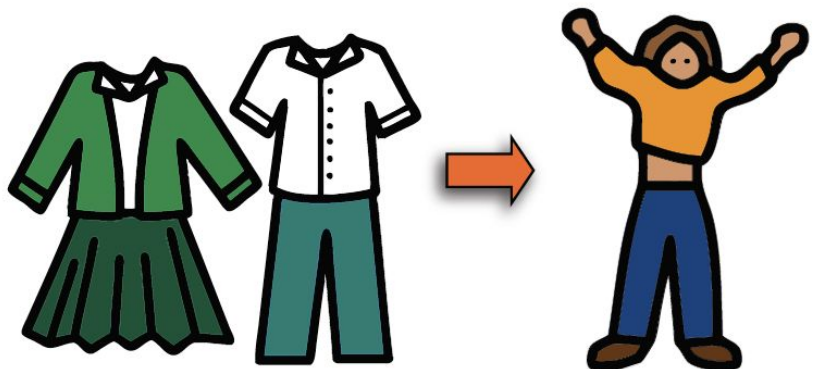
School will be a bit different to what I am used to.

I can help to put on my uniform.

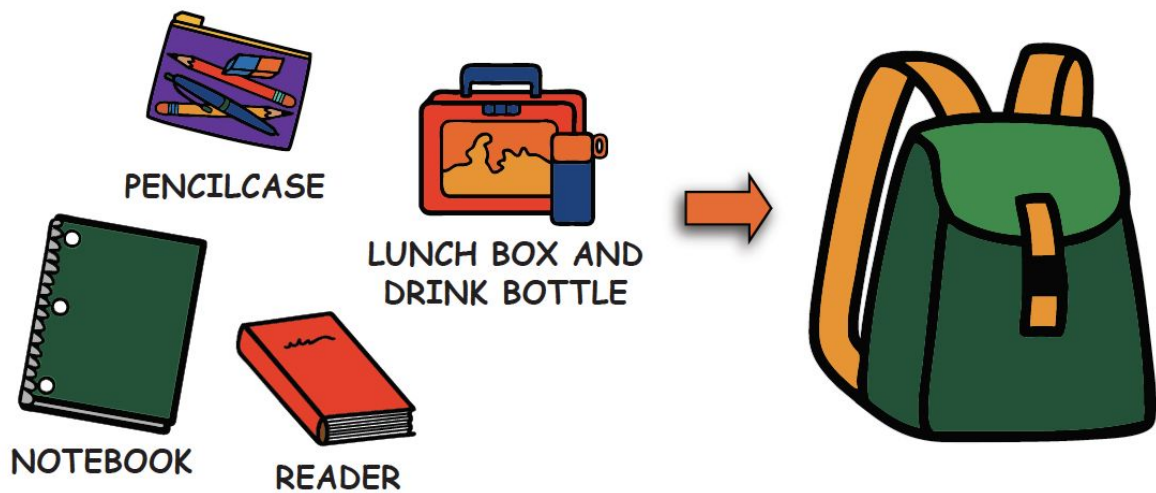


I can brush my teeth and hair.

Some things to put in my school bag are:



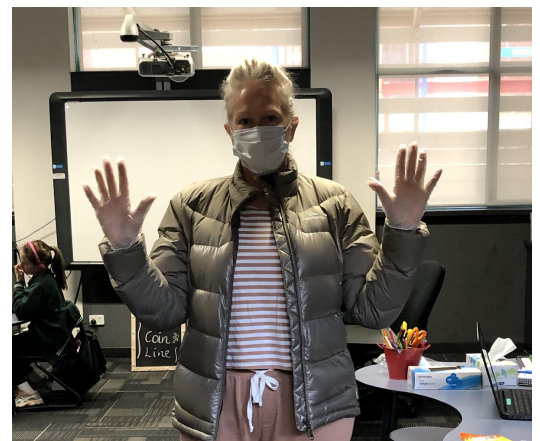


I will be dropped off and picked up from the gate on Mayona Road. Mum or Dad are not allowed into the school.

When I sanitise my hands they are clean and free from any germs.



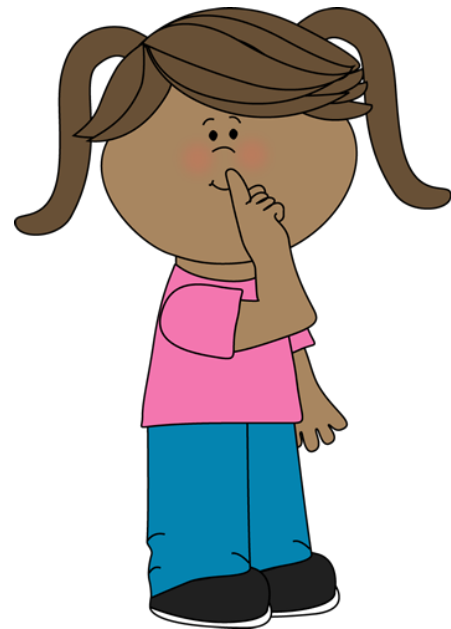
I will place my school bag next to where I will sit.



I will work at a desk for the day and keep my things at my desk.

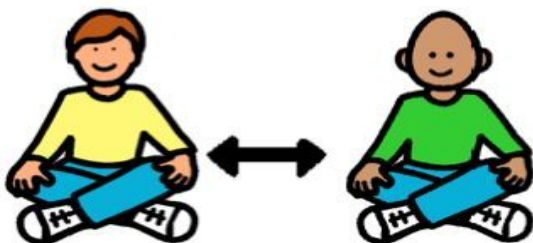
I will be working on my device with activities set by my teacher.

I will use *Google Classroom* on my device to see the activities my teacher wants me to do.

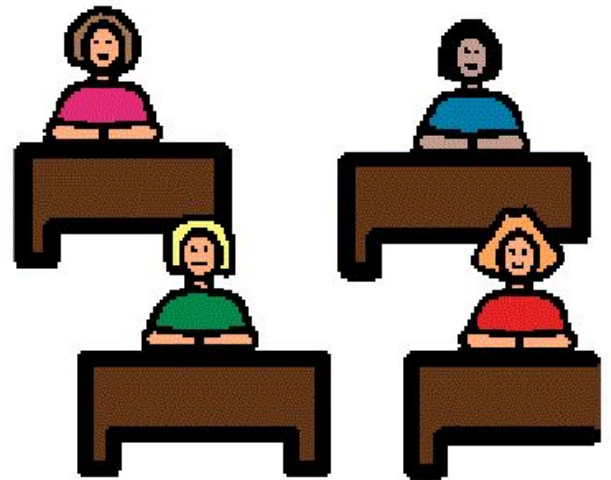
I might listen and talk to my teacher online using my headphones.

I will play outside at recess and lunch, but I cannot play on the equipment.



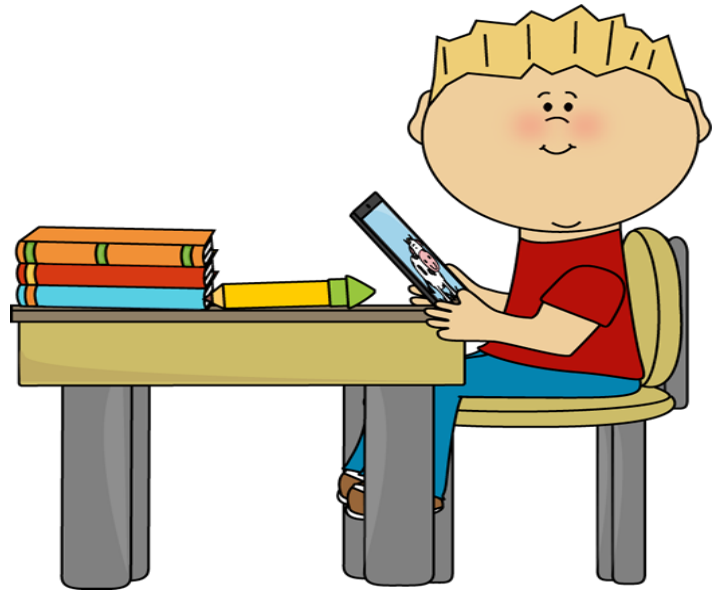
The bell and music sounds at the end of recess like usual.

after I wash my hands.

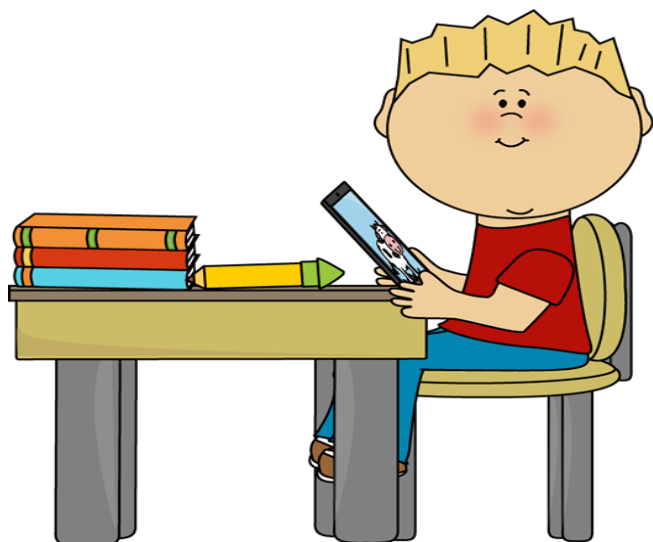
I can play outside at lunch time if it isn't raining.
