Mother's Day 2025 Stall – Thurs 8 May Morning with Mum – Fri 9 May	Danielle	The volunteer-intensive Mother's Day Breakfast will this year be replaced with a more relaxed 'Morning with Mum'. Looking to hire a coffee cart/truck to be available on school grounds from 8am with a sweet treat to be provided to all Mums, who are invited to arrive from 8am and spent time with children and other families. . Jordie, a Grade 1 Dad, will be building a Photo Booth/Station where Mums can take some happy snaps with their child/children. Following assembly, mums are invited to go to classrooms with their child/children for an activity for approx. 20 minutes. Families to be grouped by Trish. This offering was an appreciated hit in 2024. Also looking at inviting sponsors to cover a small gift each child will be able to send home with Mum – Phil clarified this cannot be funded by PA. Discussed potential disappointment about changed format, but committee highlighted preference for all Mums to be able to enjoy the morning and the lead up, without the pressure of organising and preparing food etc. Holding a breakfast like previous years will only become more challenging as the school is growing. There are also other restrictions that come into play this year with the hall being unavailable the day before for set up due to a permanent booking on Thursday evenings.
